



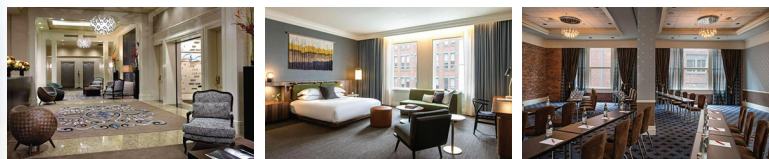

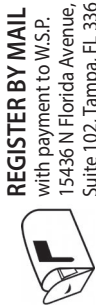

Staying current with clinical applications of power instruments has a new level of importance in this era of technology and the Oral Systemic Link research. • While air polishers have been around for 4 decades, their use was generally restricted to supragingival stain removal. Like ultrasonics with micro tips, their use with finer size powder particles has evolved into the next treatment modality for preventative and periodontal therapy.
